9:00 – 10:00 Breakfast at Dragsholm Slot

10:00 – 10:30 Drive from Dragsholm Slot to Troldhøj

10:30 – 11:30 Storytelling at Troldhøj

- Visit the old passage grave Troldhøj. While visiting Troldhøj your guests will hear tales about the place. Troldhøj dates back to the Neolithic Period and is very well-preserved.

11:30 – 11:33 Drive from Troldhøj to Niels Huang

11:40 – 12:40 Niels Huang

- At Niels Huang, your guests will experience the art of extruded ceramic. The extruder technology originated in ancient China. Niels Huang's masterpieces are unique. During the visit, your guests will learn about extruded ceramic and see some of the work of Niels Huang.

12:40 – 12:50 Drive from Niels Huang to Birkemosegaard

13:00 – 14:30 Lunch with apple juice at Birkemosegaard

- Lunch is served at Birkemosegaard, a biodynamic farm with a wide range of meat, vegetables, beverages, fruits, and more. They also have a restaurant that serves food with local and home-grown ingredients. Furthermore, the owners of Birkemosegaard will describe what biodynamic agriculture is all about.

14:30 – 14:46 Drive from Birkemosegaard to Højby Kirke

14:46 – 15:46 Storytelling about the church and frescoes in Højby Kirke

- Højby Kirke is a historic church with well-known and unique frescoes. Højby Kirke is one of the oldest churches in Zealand. The church is known worldwide for its famous frescoes. On the tour, a guide will walk your guests through the old church and the old inventory.

15:46 – 16:10 Drive from Højby Kirke to Dragsholm Slot

16:10 – 17:10 Tour at Dragsholm Slot

- The castle dates back more than 800 years. On the tour, your guests will learn about the history, the many things Dragsholm has witnessed, and the old ghost stories about the castle.
